- 6 Q. (BY MR. YATES) I hand to you what's marked State's
- 7 Exhibit Number Eighty-Nine and ask if you can identify
- 8 State's Exhibit Number Eighty-Nine.
- 9 A. Yes, I can.
- 10 Q. What is State's Exhibit Number Eighty-Nine?
- II A. It's a copy of a transaction detail sheet from Wachovia
- 12 Bank.
- 13 Q. And did you receive that in your office from the Wachovia
- 14 Security Division?
- 15 A. Yes, i did.
- 16 Q. I believe from Barbara McCure (SIC) and also the agent
- from the bank who is --
- 18 A. Barbara McQuire.
- 19 Q. McQuire I mean.
- 20 A. She's the one that transferred those documents to my
- 21 possession.
- 22 Q. Okay. And who is this transaction for on that?
- 23 A. I'm sorry?
- 24 Q. Does it indicate whose transaction sheets those are for?
- Or you asked for?

- I A. I asked for the transactions on the account of
- 2 Christopher Gailey.
- 3 Q. For Chris Gailey, okay. And I believe the system date on
- 4 that was 7/11 of '99, is that correct?
- 5 A. That's correct.
- 6 Q. And the amount of the transaction was what?
- 7 A. The transaction amount was \$200.00.
- 8 O. And where was the transaction made?
- 9 A. 4600-10 Main Street in Shallotte, North Carolina, North
- 10 Carolina State Employee's Credit Union.
- II Q. And have you maintained these records since you received
- them in 1999?
- 13 A. Yes.
- 14 Q. Okay. Hand to you what's marked STATE'S EXHIBIT NUMBER
- NINETY (90) and ask if you can identify State's Exhibit
- Number Ninety.
- 17 A. I can identify it.
- 18 Q. What is State's Exhibit Number Ninety, Officer Bunting?
- 19 A. It's another copy of a transaction detail sheet from
- 20 Wachovia Bank on the account of Christopher Gailey.
- 21 Q. And what was the amount of that transaction?
- 22 A. It was \$100.00.
- 23 Q. And what was the location there?
- 24 A. The same address, 4600-10 Main Street in Shallotte, North
- 25 Carolina, North Carolina State Employee's Credit Union.

- 1 Q. Okay. And hand you what's marked for identification
- purposes STATE'S EXHIBIT NUMBER NINETY-ONE (91) and ask
- if you can identify State's Exhibit Number Ninety-One.
- 4 A. I can.
- 5 Q. And what is State's Exhibit Number Ninety-One?
- 6 A. It's a transaction detail sheet from Wachovia Bank on the
- 7 account of Christopher Gailey.
- 8 Q. And what is the date of that transaction?
- 9 A. July the  $12^{th}$ , '99 in the amount of \$41.00.
- 10 Q. And where is the location of that transaction?
- 11 A. 710 North First Street, Albemarle, North Carolina Bank of
- 12 America, I believe.
- 13 Q. Okay. Hand you what's marked for identification purposes
- 14 STATE'S EXHIBIT NUMBER NINETY-TWO (92) and ask if you can
- identify State's Exhibit Number Ninety-Two.
- 16 A. I can identify that.
- 17 Q. What is State's Exhibit Number Ninety-Two, Officer
- Bunting?
- 19 A. It's a transaction detail sheet for Wachovia Bank on Mr.
- 20 Gailey's account.
- 21 Q. And what is the date of that transaction?
- 22 A. The  $13^{th}$  of July of '99.
- 23 Q. And what is the amount?
- 24 A. \$7.43.
- 25 Q. Where is that transaction located?

- 1 A. Citgo Number 140, Minuteman in Shallotte, North Carolina.
- 2 Q. Okay. Hand you what's marked STATE'S EXHIBIT NUMBER
- 3 NINETY-THREE (93) and ask if you can identify State's
- 4 Exhibit Number Ninety-Three.
- 5 A. Yes, sir.
- 6 Q. What is State's Exhibit Number Ninety-Three?
- 7 A. Again, it's a copy of a transaction detail sheet from
- 8 Wachovia Bank on Mr. Gailey's account.
- 9 Q. And what is the date of that transaction?
- 10 A. July the  $13^{th}$ , 1999.
- 11 O. And the location?
- 12 A. Citgo Number 140, Minuteman in Shallotte, North Carolina.
- 13 Q. And I'll hand to you what's marked for identification
- purposes STATE'S EXHIBIT NUMBER NINETY-FOUR (94) and ask
- if you can identify State's Exhibit Number Ninety-Four.
- 16 A. Yes, I can.
- 17 Q. And what is State's Exhibit Number Ninety-Four?
- 18 A. It is a copy of a transaction detail sheet again of
- Wachovia Bank on Mr. Gailey's account.
- 20 Q. And what was the amount of the transaction?
- 21 A. \$12.01.
- 22 O. Where is that located?
- 23 A. Texaco, Incorporated, 2064244548 in Rowland, North
- 24 Carolina.
- 25 Q. Are you familiar with Rowland, North Carolina?

- 1 A. I believe so.
- 2 O. Where is that located?
- 3 A. It's off of Highway 74 between Wilmington and --
- 4 Q. Shallotte or that area?
- 5 A. Rockingham would be the best --
- 6 Q. Okay. And you received these and you maintained those in
- 7 your possession and brought them here in court today, is
- 8 that a fair and accurate representation?
- 9 A. They were maintained in my possession until they were
- submitted to the main evidence officer, and they remained
- II in his custody until I took over the evidence room in
- December, and then I turned them over when I found them.
- 13 Q. Could you look at the last, I believe Number Ninety-Four
- and indicate the balance at that time. The last
- 15 transaction.
- 16 A. After this transaction was posted the current balance was
- \$1.81.
- 18 Q. Did you put the date -- I don't -- the date of the
- balance on Number Ninety-Four.
- 20 A. Well, it would have been the date that they were sent to
- 21 me, which would have been July the 29<sup>th</sup>.
- 22 Q. I meant the actual transaction.
- 23 A. That transaction was on July the 14<sup>th</sup> of '99.
- 24 Q. All right. And you received these items on July 29<sup>th</sup>?
- 25 A. That's correct.

- 1 Q. From Wachovia?
- 2 A. From Barbara McQuire.
- 3 Q. McQuire.
- 4 MR. YATES: State would move to introduce
- those, Eighty-Nine through Ninety-Four for illustrative
- 6 purposes.
- 7 THE COURT: So admitted.
- 8 Q. (BY MR. YATES) Officer Bunting, you were at the scene I
- believe the -- where the body was found on July 11<sup>th</sup>,
- 1999?
- 11 A. Yes, I was.
- 12 O. Did you see any wallets there at the scene at any point?
- 13 A. No, sir.
- 14 Q. You did see a, sort of a yellow, whatever you -- I don't
- know exactly where you found some money.
- 16 A. It was a yellow plastic, I call it a waterproof
- 17 container.
- 18 Q. And that appeared to be -- Where do you -- Do you recall
- where you found that yellow plastic --
- 20 A. I did not find it. Officer Wright had initially located
- it, and it contained an amount of United States currency.
- 22 She secured the currency and the other items that were in
- 23 it.
- 24 Q. Okay. You were there but it wasn't your job, is that --
- 25 A. That's correct.
